概 要	The goal of this course is to help students improve their paragraph and essay writing skills. By the end of the course, it is hoped that students should be able to write clear and concise paragraphs and have a better idea of what constitutes a well-written short essay.			
到 達 目 標	It will be very important to distinguish early in the course differences between “spoken” and “written” English. Additionally, there will be a strong focus on basic structural rules that apply to written English. Students will have considerable freedom in choosing topics that they wish to write about, be it current events or issues that they feel are important to them. Students will be writing several paragraphs both in class and as homework. Toward the end of the course, they will also be expected to write a short essay.
